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ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

Each employee plays an important role in getting the day's work done. Absenteeism and tardiness, even for good reasons, is disruptive to our operations and interferes with our ability to satisfy our patients' needs, therefore, every employee is expected to be at work on time each day. Regular attendance is an essential part of each employee's job function with the Company.

1. Employee attendance records will be kept by each department director and this policy will be administered evenly to all employees
2. An absence occurrence is defined as an absence from the job uninterrupted by a return to work.
3. The reason and length of an occurrence will be reviewed in each evaluation.
4. The following is the corrective discipline required for occurrences in excess of standards:
 - A. An employee who has four occurrences in a 12 month period will receive a verbal counseling informing him/her of the consequences of continued occurrences.
 - B. An employee who has six occurrences in a 12 month period will receive a written warning informing him/her of the consequences of continued occurrences.
 - C. An employee who has eight occurrences in a 12 month period will be suspended.
 - D. Termination will result if an employee has more than ten occurrences in a 12 month period.
